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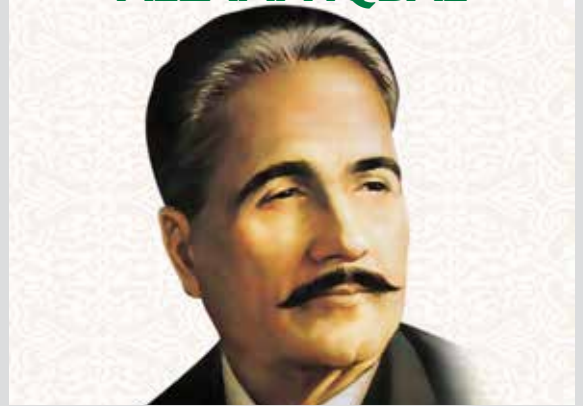
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ALLAMA IQBAL**

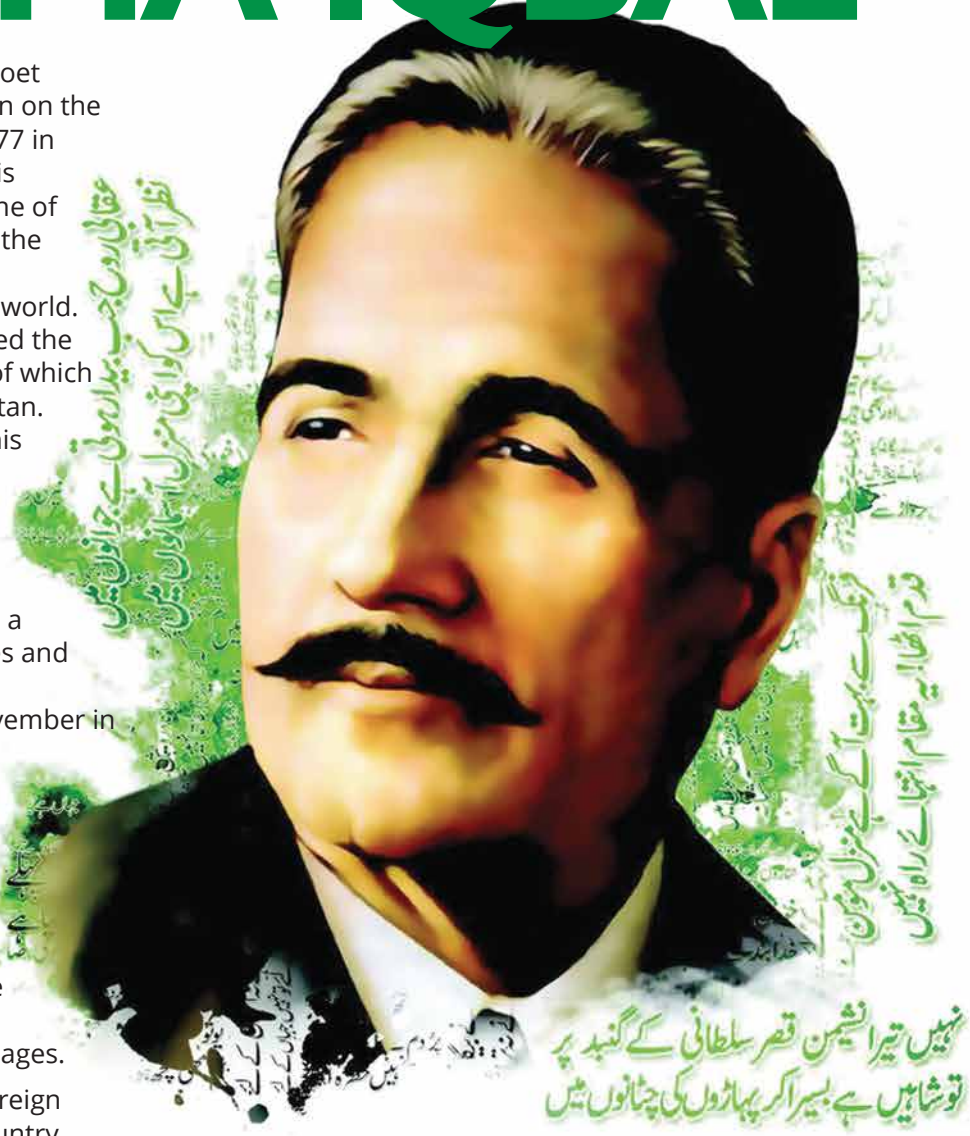
TRIBUTE TO ALLAMA IQBAL

Murree Hills

Most Popular Picnic Points of Murree Hills are Dunga Gali, Muskpuri Hill, Nathia Gali, Bara Gali and Mall Road.

Shandur Pas

Shandur is the Highest Polo Ground on Earth is about 3738 meter an above sea level and lies midway between Chitral and Gilgit. 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EDUCATION AND POVERTY

There are 25 million boys and girls between the age of 5 and 16, who are out of school. A large number of empirical studies find that increase in women's education boosts their wages and that returns to education for women are frequently larger than that of men, increase in female education improves human development outcomes.

For each and every nation it is necessary that they have a good in-built educational system with such setup which can evolve with time according to its needs.

Education is necessary for everyone, we all are aware of its importance and its impact on society but still there are many people who are not able to get good education or don't even know the approach how to get it.

Poverty is one of the major reasons in our country which is jolting the future of our people. This is also the reason of our low literacy rate. We despite all our good intentions and efforts are not able to create a system where poor and rich can study at same level and get judged only on basis of their abilities.

The main problem of our country is Education. Especially, in rural areas, almost 90% of people are illiterate. This is because of the ancestors of the particular area. Everyone is involved in farming. The farmers earn money from agriculture and that is the only source for earning money. This is because no one is there who invests on education. The main role is of government, who never invest in it. We have to maintain a good environment, a good class in which many children come themselves and learn. But, in the rural area of Pakistan parents never send their children to schools. They are born to play with mud or might help their parents in the fields, and that's it, no studies at all.

As the time passes, their parents order them to work with them on regularly bases. Every elder son is an asset for every family. Another problem which they face is, low earning. They work so hard but in return they never earn a high figure. This is because they have no knowledge, and just want to fill their empty stomach. Purchaser comes and purchase their fields in a very small amount of money, and then they sale them in high rates to the cities. This is happening because the farmers have no education at all; no education means, no knowledge, which indicates that you cannot make a good decision and you just do the things.

That's why it's important for them to get education. They always face the problems, either it is of money or of calculations. If anyone wants to learn they always back out because no one is there who motivates them. There are only 10 to 20% of schools in rural areas but accommodation level is 0. We have to work on it, youngsters may help them by social media and the ones who owns an authority may work for



them and visit there place so that motivation view can be seen.

Although urban areas have higher student enrollment and better learning outcomes, close to 10 percent of all children in Lahore, Karachi and Peshawar remain out of school. Like healthcare, better education in cities is explained by the private sector. From 2001 to 2014, the share of primary enrollment in urban private schools rose from 25 percent to 40 percent. Moreover, there seems to be an inverse relationship between public schooling and city size. In small cities, approximately 35 percent of all children aged five to nine are enrolled in government schools. In capital cities, that figure drops to 22 percent.

Continued preference for private schools reflects the low quality of government schools in urban centers. While all private schools have basic facilities (drinkable water and toilets), they are missing in around 12 percent of government schools in Lahore, the absence of educational and health facilities in smaller cities pushes people towards big cities, where service delivery becomes increasingly strained as the urban population grows.

According to Media Reports, Pakistan has an estimated population of 195.4 million in 2016; however, the population was 191.71 million in 2015. In Pakistan, only about 1 percent of the population is registered in the tax system and the government collects just 9 percent of the country's wealth in taxes which is the lowest in the world. Education is the most important instrument for human resource development; it has become a universal and an important component of opportunities and empowerment.

There are 25 million boys and girls between the age of 5 and 16, who are out of school. A large number of empirical studies find that increase in women's education boosts their wages and that returns to education for women are frequently larger than that of men, increase in female education improves human development outcomes. Lower female education had a negative impact on economic growth. In developing countries female education reduces fertility infant mortality and increases children education.

In Human Development Report Pakistan is placed at 136th position for having just 49.9% educated population. In addition to that, Pakistan is ranked at 113th out of 120 registered UN members according to the research conducted by UNESCO et al. Some of the very basic flaws of the education system in Pakistan contribute to the economic, ethnic and sociopolitical crisis within the country.

Moreover, the quality of education in most of the public schools and colleges is well below par; the teachers in government schools are not well trained. People who do not get job in any other sector, they try their luck in educational system. They are not professionally trained teachers so they are unable to train a nation. Quality of teaching needs special attention in rural areas where the teachers lack in all departments.

Poverty is another factor that prohibits the parents to send their children to private school where the quality of education is high. Poor people get their children admitted to Government schools. The teachers in Government schools are not professionally trained. They even don't take lectures and waste the precious time of the students.

The allocation of funds for education sector by the Government of Pakistan are very low; only 2% of the total GDP. Government should increase this rate to improve the quality of educational system.

Education is very important for the development of every country. It is the only cure for the disability of a country because today's students are tomorrow's nation builder. Government of



Education is very important for the development of every country. It is the only cure for the disability of a country because today's students are tomorrow's nation builder.

Pakistan should take steps to remove the above mentioned problems so as to improve the quality of educational system of the country.

Estimating the value of education, the Government should take solid steps on this issue. Implementation instead of projecting policies should be focused on. Allocation of funds should be made easy from provinces to districts and then to educational institutes. Workshops must be arranged for teachers. Foreign states are using LSS system. This should be inducted in Pakistani schools to improve the hidden qualities of children. Technical education must be given to all the classes. The education board of Punjab has projected a plan to give tech- education to the children of industrial workers. Promotion of the primary education is the need of time. Teachers, professors and educationists should be consulted while devising any plan, syllabus or policy. The state seems to give up her responsibility and totally relying on private sector. The need of time is to bring education in its original form to masses. Burdening students with so many books will not work as he will not understand what the world is going to do next moment. Education is the only cure of the instability in the state and can bring revolution through evolution, by eradicating the social evils. This is how to remove illiteracy in Pakistan.

Parents and local residents are very cooperative with the educational activities of the school, including educational volunteers, who are working closely together to support education; for residents of the community, especially for self-governing associations.





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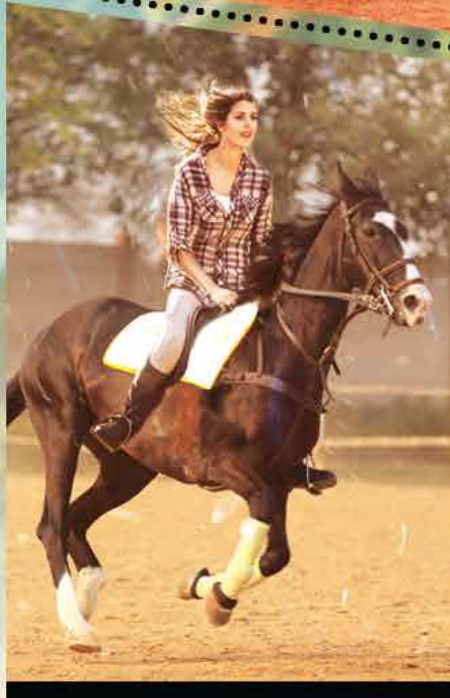

Door of Awareness

Interview of Ms. Ruba Humayun Chairperson

Q. How the journey of "Door of Awareness" started?

Answer. Initially, my family use to distribute food to poor people on every Thursday, and while distributing the food I use to observe that deprived people use to snatch and fight over food, and then I started organizing them before distributing the food to them, which they also learned. After this, we expanded and over the passage of time started giving "education", "books", "uniforms", "basic hygiene items", and "training", along with food. This took a form of a Non-Profit organisation "Door of Awareness".

Q. What was the reason to start "Door of Awareness"?

Answer. Our main reason to start was to provide education and create awareness. When In 2007, I (Ms. Ruba Humayun) started a teaching centre in the slums of Gulberg III. After, I met and observed children in the slums of Gulberg at the time of distribution of food and gifts; I realized that Education was the only solution. Most of them were begging or working and had never been to school. Patiently, lovingly and gently volunteers gained children's trust and attention, and Door of Awareness started to fulfill its aim.

Q. How was your experience to educating children of slum areas?

Answer. Initially, I picked many children and gave them books, uniforms and other basic things and got them enrolled in different schools. But after some time, they again use to go back to their previous routine and didn't use to go to school. I didn't lost hope; I hired some teachers to go in their slum areas to provide them education. In this way I manage to give education to a more number of children, in a continuous form.

Q. How was your equation with the parents of

children?

Answer. Our equation with their parents was very technical, as they use to drop out their children from schools and use to make them labor to earn some money, but then we realized the problem of parents as well, and started giving them education, training and awareness also, in order to make a strong 2 way bond. We give training to male in various units such as UPS repairing and Mobile repairing centers, and soon after getting the training they are able to earn a decent amount to support their families.

Q. Tell us about your current projects?

Answer. DOA currently operates 15 schools in and outside Lahore for the children living in slums. Since the students are most likely need to contribute towards sharing the economic burden of their family at an early age, DOA is working towards facilitating skill training for the older students. Our staff surveys the areas in which the schools are operating and forms linkages with shop keeper to train the children in various skills e.g. barbers, tailors, motor mechanics. In this way it is ensured that the children are learning in a safe environment and are not being exploited. As part of our vocational training for adults, DOA has established 3 stitching centers within the teaching units, aimed at girls and women from underprivileged backgrounds. We currently have 150 girls enrolled in our evening classes of computer training courses.

Q. Any Message for our readers?

Answer. Now at this point, we should play a role as a true Pakistani and bring a desired change. Bring your passion to work, as it is not the time to think, but to act upon your aims. We will be obliged if you join our platform to educate underprivileged and help Pakistan to fight against the illiteracy war.



Health Tips for Students

ANGRY BIRDS 2

How does it compare to the original?

The very first Angry Birds game was launched in December 2009. Since then, it has collected over 100 million downloads in the Google Play Store and currently holds almost 3 million 5-star reviews. This application is off the charts and continues to be one of the most entertaining casual games around, but we do have to say a successor was due after 6 years.

We have seen plenty of other Angry Birds iterations, but those were really just themed titles. Is Angry Birds 2 a worthy successor to what could be the most popular mobile game in existence? We at least know it will probably be as popular, as it has been downloaded over 10 million times since its inception, last week. It definitely has its pros and cons, though, so let's dig into the details.

Game-Play

You have played Angry Birds before, right? If you answered "no", you really need to get out of that rock you are living under. The game is very similar to what we have seen from Angry Birds titles in the past. Those annoying green pigs are back at it, taking all your eggs for themselves. Your goal is to recover these unborn birds by flinging fowl at structures and oddly colored swine. Just take them on before running out of birds.

Your score will be based on performance (birds used and structure destruction), which, in turn, determines how many stars you receive (limit is 3). It's also possible to unlock spells and easily beat any stage. As with the previous iteration, each bird has its specific characteristics and abilities, which can be triggered by tapping on the screen when the bird is in mid flight.

The red bird sends a blow to anything in front of it, the smaller blue bird splits

into three, the white one throws an egg bomb, the yellow one can fly faster and the new gray character can fly drop straight down and smash its opponents. There are 240 stages to play, so you won't exactly run out of fun, especially considering there is now the addition of the Arena, in which you can play for as long as your birds will last you.

Angry Birds vs. Angry Birds 2

You have probably figured out some of the differences in the new Angry Birds iteration just by playing it or watching some of the trailers. There's quite a bit, though, so we thought it would be important to touch on them so you know what you are getting into.

Each stage has levels

Instead of playing only one scenario, Angry Birds 2 has multiple levels within each single stage. There are usually 2-4 areas per stage, all with different structures and pigs. This makes it imperative that you choose your birds intelligently and form a good strategy. You don't want to run out of birds before reaching other areas of the stage.

Red bird has ability!

While we are used to seeing the red bird have no added ability, such is not the case in Angry Birds 2. The lead protagonist now emits a blow that will blast anything in front of it.

The new gray bird

Some say its silver, some say its gray, but whatever color you prefer to call it, and one thing is for sure this bird is awesome. Just send it flying in any direction and tap on the screen when you want it to swoop around and drop downward, smashing anything on its way.

PLOT

With such support, the festival gets underway.

The ponies of Equestria prepare for their first Friendship Festival, which is overseen by Princess Twilight Sparkle in Canterlot. The festivities are interrupted by an invasion of monstrous storm creatures commanded by the broken-horned unicorn Tempest Shadow, who uses magical obsidian orbs to petrify Twilight's fellow princesses; Princess Celestia unsuccessfully urges Princess Luna to seek help south of Equestria, uttering "the queen of the hippo" before being interrupted. Twilight flees the city alongside her five pony friends – Pinkie Pie, Rainbow Dash, Rarity, Applejack, Fluttershy and her dragon, Spike, setting out in search of the

aforementioned "hippos". Tempest is contacted by her superior, the Storm King, who reminds her to gather all of Equestria's princesses in order to activate his mystical staff with their magic, promising to restore her horn in exchange.

In the desert city of Klugetown, feline con artist Capper falsely offers to guide the seven friends to the hippos, secretly intending to sell the ponies to settle a debt to a local criminal. However, he develops a genuine friendship with them after Rarity generously mends his coat. Twilight discovers an atlas in Capper's manor that reveals the "hippos" to be hippogriffs, exposing Capper's treachery. Tempest arrives in pursuit of Twilight, forcing the seven to hide aboard a delivery airship.

The airship's birdlike crews reluctantly allow the seven passages during a lunch break, revealing themselves to be former pirates that have been forced into the Storm King's service. Rainbow Dash persuades the pirates to defy orders and take the seven to the hippogriffs' kingdom on Mount Aris, performing a Sonic Rainboom that inadvertently gives their location away to Tempest. Disgruntled by her friends' carelessness, Twilight engineers her group's escape in a makeshift hot air balloon, leaving Tempest to destroy the ship with the pirates and Capper on board.

The Friendship Festival resumes and the ponies celebrate with all of the allies they have made on their adventure. Tempest, disheartened by her still broken horn, is convinced by Twilight to join them by producing a fireworks display with her magic, happily accepting the friendship of Twilight and her company.

During the celebration, Twilight tells the now forgiven Tempest that she is already very powerful, horn or not and invites her to stay in Equestria. Moved by Twilight's offer, Tempest at least uses her still considerable magic to make the light show the Princess of Friendship originally wanted. As they then move to join the festivities, Tempest quietly tells Pinkie Pie her real name 'Fizzlop Berrytwist' and Pinkie Pie ends the movie by joyously shrieking how wonderful that name is.

Nutritional Requirements of Toddlers, their Meal Plan and from meal plan; Recipe of Scrambled Eggs.

Toddlers and young children up to the age of five should be given a wide variety of foods because at this age, growth and activity are greatly increased. Eggs, milk, meat, and cheese should be given in plenty as they are an excellent source of protein which is essential for body growth, repair and maintenance. These foods are also a rich source of calcium and vitamin D. Calcium and Vitamin D are both required for strong bones and teeth. Fluoride also gives strength to the teeth. Iron is a very important nutrient at this age. It is a component of haemoglobin which carries oxygen and transports it to every cell within the body for the production of energy. Since children are very active at this age, they need plenty of energy. Therefore, iron plays a major role in energy production. Beef, liver,

green leafy vegetables, should be eaten in plenty to get this mineral.

A child's appetite may vary from day to day, however parents should not force them to eat. They should be discouraged from eating between meals specially sweets and snacks such as crisp that lead to obesity and tooth decay.

They should not be offered such foods even when they are upset about something as this habit would continue into adulthood, leading to obesity.

A calm but firm attitude towards food by parents help develop good eating habits in children. Foods should be attractively served so that children enjoy eating them.



Meal plan for toddler:

Breakfast:

Cornflakes into milk, scrambled eggs, toast with butter.

Midday meal:

Chicken with pasta in tomato and vegetable sauce, water, fruit crumble.

Evening meal:

Fish burger, small piece of cake and fruit juice.

Recipe:

Scrambled eggs

Ingredients:

- 2 Eggs,
- 2tbsp Milk
- Half oz Butter
- 1 oz grated cheese
- 4 Slices bread
- 1 Tomato
- Salt and pepper

Method:

Break the eggs in a small bowl and beat. Add seasoning. Melt butter in a saucepan over low heat and add the egg mixture to it. Continue to cook on a low heat. Stirring the mixture all the time with wooden spoon until thick and creamy. Do not overcook. Remove from heat and add grated cheese. Pile this mixture on a hot toast and serve for breakfast or cool the mixture and use a sandwich paste.

Bread Cheese Rolls

INSTRUCTIONS



1. Place the crumbled cheese in a wide bowl.
2. Add the red chilli powder, salt, chopped coriander, chopped onion, and cumin to this and mix lightly with your finger tips.
3. Then add the tomato sauce or ketchup and the ginger garlic paste and blend again with finger tips and set aside while you prepare the bread.
4. Remove the crusts from your bread. Use the regular white supermarket variety.
5. Roll out each slice as thin as you can. Regular bread that's fresh and soft should be easy to roll out and place about 1 tsp or so of filling on one end of the rolled out bread slice.
6. Gently roll in from one end, making sure that the filling stays well within the first turn of the roll and repeat with the remaining bread slices.
7. Lightly toast in a skillet or pan until all sides are browned.
8. Cut and serve with tomato sauce.

INGREDIENTS

- 1 cup crumbled cheese
- 1 small onion, chopped fine
- ½ tsp red chilli powder
- ¼ tsp powdered cumin
- ½ tsp ginger garlic paste
- A small bunch of coriander, chopped fine

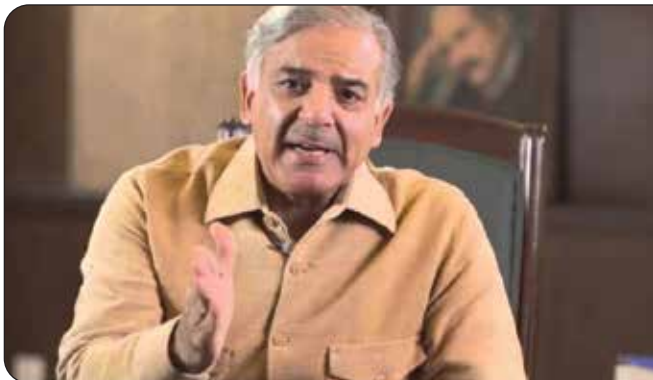
Environment Minister Meets Pakistan Private Schools Management Association

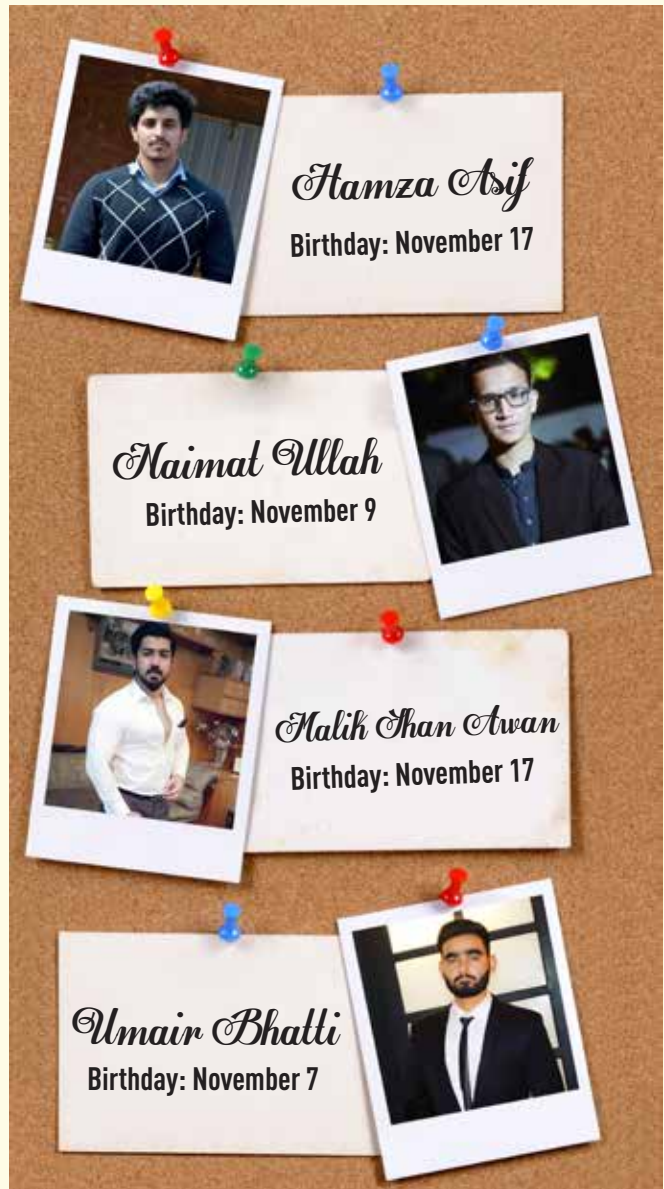

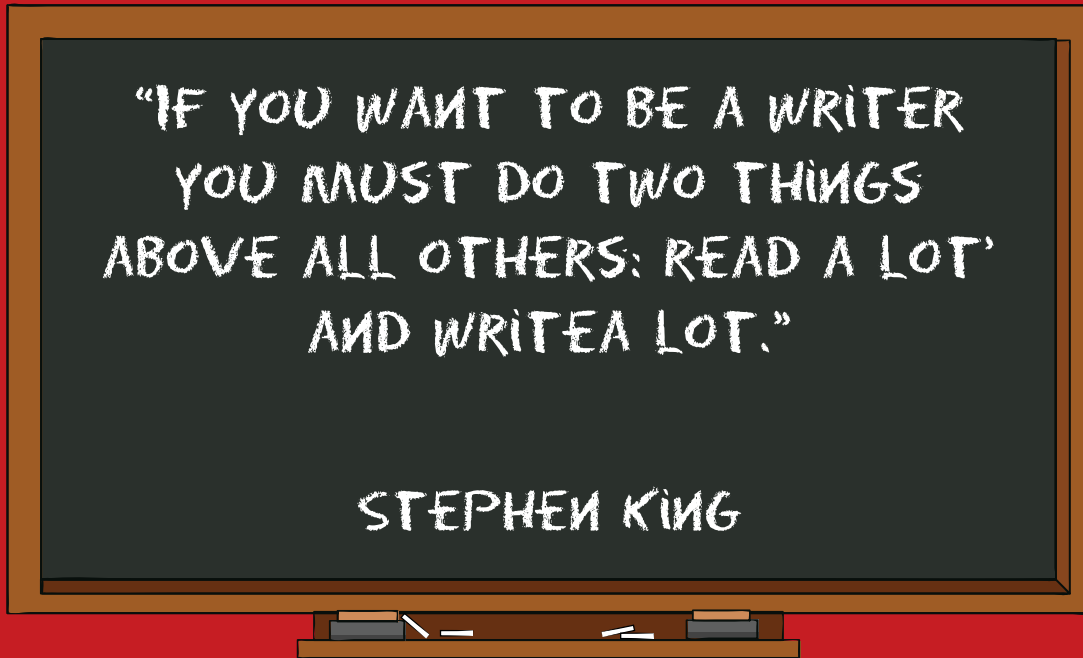
